ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On February 3, 1984, Mobil Chemical Co. (Mobil) filed an Amended Petition for Variance seeking an extension of the variance previously granted in PCB 82-18 (November 12, 1982, 49 PCB 275). On page 8, the Amended Petition requests variance from the ammonia nitrogen water quality standard of 15 mg/l.

In PCB 82-18 Mobil was granted a variance from the 15 mg/l water quality standard of 35 Ill. Admin. Code 302.208. Since that time the ammonia nitrogen requirements of Section 302.208 have been deleted and replaced by Section 302.212 which regulates ammonia nitrogen and un-ionized ammonia. Mobil has provided no information on un-ionized ammonia levels nor requested limitations to replace Section 302.212 (b).

Unless an Amended Petition is filed within 45 days of the date of this Order curing the above-noted defect, this petition will be subject to dismissal.

On p. 8 of the Amended Petition, Mobil asserts that Outfall 002 is not a point source within the purview of the Clean Water Act. The parties are requested to address this issue in light of U.S. v. Oxford Royal Mushroom Products 14 ERC 1321 (E.D. Penn, 1980).
