ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

Based on the information submitted by the Petitioner on January 26, 1984, it appears to the Board that variance is requested from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 203, entitled Major Stationary Source Construction and Modification. Petitioner is directed to clarify the Sections in that and any other part of the Board's air regulations contained in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 200 et seq. it seeks variance from.

The Petition for Variance is deficient for additional reasons. It fails to include any specifics about the construction or modification apparently already done on Press No. 4, for which it sought a permit from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. The dates and details of the work done should be submitted to the Board, as well as a more detailed account of the press' actual operation and emissions. Petitioner is likewise directed to submit the standard information required by the Board's Procedural Rules at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.121, entitled Contents of a Variance Petition.

Petitioner has forty-five days from the date of this order to amend its original Petition for Variance with the information requested. The 90 day decision period will begin the day of the amendments are filed. Failure to do so will render the Petition subject to dismissal.
