ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On February 9, 1984, the City of Wyoming ("Wyoming") filed a petition for variance from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 306.105(b), restricted status. It appears Wyoming in fact is asking for a variance from Sections 309.202 and 309.203 which prohibit construction and operation of wastewater sources without an Agency permit.

The petition by Wyoming fails to include certain information necessary for a Board determination on this matter, including:

- 1. What aspect of the municipal sewage treatment facility is on restricted status, what is the basis for restricted status, and when was restricted status imposed?
- 2. What is the current status of the problem leading to restricted status, e.g., have flows increased or decreased?
- 3. What is the schedule for completion of improvements to lift restricted status?
- 4. What are the increased flows and environmental impact from the sewers for which variance is sought?
- 5. When was the CDAP grant requested and approved; What local funds have been expended and when?
- 6. A description of the existing and proposed facility, see Section 104.121(f).
- 7. A statement as to consistency with federal law. See Section 104.122(b).

Unless an amended petition is filed within 45 days of the date of this Order curing the above-noted defects, this petition will be subject to dismissal.
