ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On November 18, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Cunningham Service (Cunningham) may appeal an October 11, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency rejected the proposed budget for the high priority corrective action plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at Rural Route 1, Box 109 in West Salem, Edwards County. The Board extends the appeal period until February 13, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Cunningham fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
