ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On May 19, 1983 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a motion for extension of time to file its variance recommendation in this matter. It argues that since a site-specific regulatory proceeding was filed contemporaneously with the variance petition and since the compliance plan stated in that petition is to obtain site-specific relief, the Agency should have 90 days to file its variance recommendation to allow it the same period of time as it is allowed to make a recommendation as to the disposition of the site-specific regulation pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 106.304(a). It further argues that the filing of the site-specific regulatory petition should be construed as a pro tanto waiver of the 90-day decision period for Board action.

This novel argument is not devoid of merit. However, the Board concludes that it has no authority to construe the filing of a site-specific regulatory petition as a waiver of the Board's statutory decision period for the variance action. Therefore, the Board cannot allow the requested 60-day extension. The motion is hereby denied.
