RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (By J.D. Dumelle):

On November 23, 1982 the United States Environmental Protection Agency published notice (47 Fed. Reg. 52932) of the adoption of an amendment to 40 CFR Part 60 -- Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources which added Subpart HHH -- Synthetic Fiber Production Facilities.

On November 29, 1982, USEPA published a correction notice (47 Fed. Reg. 53746) for Standards of Performance for New Stationary sources; Synthetic Fiber Production Facilities. In the first column in the "DATES" paragraph, in the fifth line "February 23, 1982" should read "December 23, 1982".

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, the Board hereby adopts the above-noted amendment as Rule 968 of Part IX: New Source Performance Standards of Chapter 2: Air Pollution.
