ORDER OF THE BOARD (by I.G. Goodman):

On December 16, 1982 Unity Ventures (Unity) moved for reconsideration of the Board's Order of December 2, 1982. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a Response on December 22, 1982 and Unity filed a Motion for Leave to File a Reply and a Reply on December 28, 1982. The Motion for Leave to File is granted.

The Motion for Reconsideration and the Reply forward no new arguments or information than those considered by the Board prior to the December 2, 1982 Order. Motion is denied.

Contained within the Motion for Reconsideration is a request to amend the variance petition now before the Board. That request is granted. Unity has fifteen days from the date of this Order to file its Amended Petition with the Board. The ninety-day decision period will then begin anew. (35 Ill. Adm. Code 402.181.) The Agency will then have 30 days to file an Amended Recommendation. The hearing officer is directed to schedule and hold a hearing in this matter in sufficient time for the Board to render a decision within that ninety day decision period.
