

2. Borden shall continue sampling its effluent in accordance with its NPDES permit;
3. Effluent concentrations of suspended solids discharged shall not exceed 18 mg/l on a monthly average basis or 30 mg/l on a daily maximum basis;
4. The contents of any final polishing lagoons removed from service shall be recirculated through the entire treatment process prior to discharge;
5. Within ten days of the date of this Order, Borden shall execute a certificate of acceptance and agreement in the following form:
