ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

On November 6, 1981 A. S. Hansen, Inc. filed a petition for variance from Rules 203(d), 402, 910(a)(4) and 910(b) of Chapter 3: Water Pollution. That petition is defective in numerous respects under Procedural Rule 401. Of most concern are the following deficiencies"

- If no contaminants are discharged, then no variance is needed.
- 2. If there is a discharge for which variance is needed, what contaminants are discharged and at what level?
- 3. What is the receiving stream if there is such a discharge?
- 4. Is this actually a septic system or some form of small package plant?
- 5. What is the cost of compliance?
- 6. What will be the effect upon the environment?
- 7. Hearing is neither waived nor requested. If hearing is waived, the Board notes that such waiver must be accompanied by an appropriate affidavit (Rule 401(b)).

Unless Hansen submits an amended petition within 45 days of the date of this Order curing the above-noted deficiencies, this petition will be subject to dismissal.
