ORDER OF THE BOARD (by I. Goodman):

Joint motion for stay of proceedings through May 13, 1981, filed March 16, 1981, is granted. Waiver shall be for a like period, <u>e.g.</u>, 58 days from the present decision date of May 5, 1981, or until July 2, 1981.

The Board has granted similar stays (Orders of October 18, 1979, May 1, 1980, July 10, 1980, September 4, 1980, November 20, 1980, and January 22, 1981) and notes that a more expedient procedure would be to waive the decision period until so many days after an event certain, such as the filing with the Board of a motion to proceed with this case. It is to be noted that thirty days can be an insufficient period within which to, without further waiver, begin proceedings, set and hold all necessary hearings, receive briefs, review transcripts and enter an Opinion and Ordes. The Board requests that the parties keep this in mind.
