ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

On March 23, 1981 the Village of Algonquin filed a petition for variance from Rule 1201 of Chapter 3: Water Pollution. That petition is deficient in two respects. First, hearing is purportedly waived unless "a favorable order is not issued." A waiver cannot be conditioned upon a Board decision in the matter. Algonquin may have meant "recommendation" rather than order, but if so, it must so state. Second, paragraph 5 of the petition regarding hardship and costs is not sufficiently detailed.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the Village of Algonquin cure the above-noted deficiencies by an amended petition to be filed within 45 days of the date of this order, or the petition will be subject to dismissal.
