ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

On April 13, 1981 the Agency moved to dismiss this petition filed April 9, 1981, for failure to provide two pieces of information. The first is the affidavit required by Rule 401(b) attesting to the truth of the facts asserted, since hearing was waived. The second is failure to state whether the Village is part of a regional water supply/transport system, since under federal law belonging to a system would make the Village eligible for variance until January 1, 1986, a period two years longer than if the Village was not a member of such a system.

The motion to dismiss is denied. Instead, the Village is ordered to file an amended petition remedying the noted deficiencies. If an amended petition is not filed within 45 days of the date of this Order, this petition will be subject to dismissal.
