DISSENTING OPINION (by Mr. Dumelle):

I fully agree with the findings of violation in this case. However, the contingent penalty of \$14,000 is much too large for a city of 3,984 population.

A small city with part-time and usually low-salaried employes might easily fail to meet some condition of the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement which the majority of the Board has now accepted. The Board should not levy a high contingent penalty in the expectation that it will never come due.

I would have rejected the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement because of the contingent penalty.
