On September 26, 1978, Petitioner filed a Request for Clarification of the Board's Order of July 6, 1978. The Agency filed a response on October 6, 1978.

The Order required compliance with paragraph 1-C of the Order when grant funds became available. Since Step II grant priority was certified to USEPA on September 7, 1978, Petitioner shall incorporate in any design and specification adequate provision for the installation of equipment for the removal of phosphorus which will provide the best practicable treatment technology for the removal of phosphorus over the life of the works.
