ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Young):

On May 4, 1978, Village of Bloomingdale, Illinois, filed a Petition for Variance from the requirements of Rules 203(d), 203(f) (ammonia nitrogen), 404(f) (BOD₅/SS), and 962(a) of Chapter 3: Water Pollution Regulations. The Petition is inadequate for failure to request or waive a hearing as required by Procedural Rule 401(b). The Petition also fails to include a full account of the water quality data downstream from Petitioner's discharge as required by Procedural Rule 401(a)(7).

Petitioner will be granted 45 days from the date of this Order to amend this Petition or it will be dismissed as inadequate. The 90-day period will begin to run on the filing of the Amended Petition.
