ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle) :

On May 9, 1978 Petitioner requested a variance to allow the burning of wood waste. The Petition is insufficient in several respects. First, it fails to identify the Board Regulation the proposed burning would violate as required by Procedural Rule 401(a) (1). Second, it does not provide any data on the costs associated with compliance as required by Procedural Rule 401(a) (6). Third, there is no assessment of the environmental impact of the requested relief as required by Procedural Rule 401(a) (7). Fourth, the Petition fails to specifically request or waive a hearing as required by Procedural Rule 401(b).

If these inadequacies are not corrected within fortyfive (45) days of the date of this Order, this matter will be subjected to dismissal.
