RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):
On June 10, 1987 the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) published notice (52 Fed. Reg. 21003) of the promulgation of an amendment to the National Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources (NSPS):
Appendix F: Quality Assurance Procedures 40 CFR 60 (35 Ill. Adm. Code 230.Appendix F)
Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Environmental Protection Act the Board is required to adopt amendments "in substance identical" to the federal NSPS amendments. The Board will do so through incorporation by reference of the federal amendment as a peremptory amendment.
On June 10, 1987, the Board adopted a Resolution and Order under docket R87-17 pursuant to notice (52 Fed. Reg. 21003) incorporating the federal amendment into 35 Ill. Adm. Code 230. Subsequent to this Order, the Board has been informed that the source incorporating the amendment was incorrect. Therefore, the Board will amend its Resolution and Order of June 10, 1987, to reflect the correct reference.
ORDER
The Board hereby adopts the following amendments to Title 35: Environmental Protection Subtitle B: Air Pollution; Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Part 230: New Source Performance Standards:
Appendix F: Quality Assurance Procedures
The Board incorporates by reference 40 CFR 60, Appendix F (1986): 52 Fed. Reg. 21003, June 4, 1987.
