ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):


On September 13, 1999, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and petitioner filed a request for extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (1998)), relating to an August 5, 1999 Agency determination. On November 4, 1999, the Board received petitioner's petition for review. The final determination concerns petitioner's site located at 1190 South Main, Red Bud, Randolph County, Illinois. The Board accepts this matter for hearing.

The Board's rules require that the Agency file the entire Agency record of the request for reimbursement for certain corrective action costs application within 14 days of notice of the petition. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.102. Hearing must be scheduled and completed in a timely manner, pursuant to the applicable statutory decision deadline, or the decision deadline as extended by a waiver. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.105.

Absent any future waivers of the decision deadline, the statutory decision deadline is now March 3, 2000 (120 days from November 4, 1999); the Board meeting immediately preceding the decision deadline is scheduled for March 2, 2000.
