ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodmann)

On January 9, 1978, the Change Springfield submitted a Motion for Reconsideration of the Board worder of December 8, 1977, which had denied the City's Petition of Variance. The Motion for Reconsideration alleges that the Federal Clean Water Act of 1977, signed into law on December 27, 15%, would allow the Board to 1980e the requested variance. The Agence filed its Objection to Motion for Reconsideration on January 26, 1978.

It is not appropriate for the Board to reconsider a prior Order based upon complex factual and legal questions which were not at issue at the time the Order was entered. The Motion for Reconsideration is, therefore, denied. The City can, of course, apply again for a variance.
