

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On December 11, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Tri-Town Service, Inc. (Tri-Town) may appeal an October 28, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of Tri-Town's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 5020 St. Charles Road in Bellwood, Cook County. The Board extends the appeal period until March 2, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Tri-Town fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
