ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

On March 24, 1978 Petitioner requested a Variance from the requirements of Rule 203(g)(1)(B) of the Board's Air Pollution Control regulations. The Petition is insufficient for the following reasons. First, it fails to state the actual quantity of particulate matter emitted as required by Procedural Rule 401(a)(4). Second it fails to include a time schedule for compliance as required by Procedural Rule 401(a)(6). Third it fails to assess the environmental impact of the requested relief as required by Procedural Rule 401(a)(7). In addition, it fails to allege ultimate compliance by July 1, 1979, the date mandated by the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1977. If these inadequacies are not corrected within 45 days of the date of this Order, this matter will be subject to dismissal.
