ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On December 19, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Main Station (Main) may appeal a November 12, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency modified the corrective action plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 401 West Main in Staunton, Macoupin County. The Board extends the appeal period until March 17, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406 is a storage tank site at 401 West Main in Staunton, Macoupin County. The Board extends the appeal period until March 17, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Main fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
