## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On January 2, 2003, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) may appeal a November 26, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency modified IDOT's Low Priority Groundwater Monitoring Plan and IDOT's proposed budget regarding a leaking underground storage tank site located at One Langhorne Bond Drive in Sangamon County. The Board extends the appeal period until March 31, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If IDOT fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
