CONCURRING OPINION (by Mr. Dumelle):

While I agree with the essence of the decision in this cause, I do not agree with the dismissal of Count II on the narrow legal grounds that ownership of Boiler No. 7 was not stipulated.

Boiler No. 7 has been before this Board in other proceedings and the Board could have taken note of those prior proceedings. Boiler No. 7 has had testimony generated about it in this proceeding and no one has stated that the Village of Winnetka did not own it.

Finally, if Boiler No. 8 (the main issue in this cause) is in fact owned by the Village, is it not logical that Boiler No. 7 in the same power plant is also owned by the Village?
