

This Opinion constitutes the Board's findings of fact and conclusions of law.

ORDER

The Board hereby grants Olin Corporation a Variance from Water Pollution Regulation 408(a) (suspended solids) from January 2, 1977 to and including June 30, 1977 to allow the construction of a total recycle system at its Joliet, Illinois phosphate plant subject to the following conditions:

- A. Petitioner shall apply for and obtain all necessary permits. (eg: permits which may be required in eliminating Petitioner's contaminated storm flows).
- B. Petitioner shall submit to the Agency for approval by March 30, 1977, an amended compliance plan indicating: all wastewater sources which are tributary to Petitioner's storm drainage systems; methods for eliminating these contaminated wastewater sources or for providing sufficient treatment to comply with Chapter 3 effluent standards; and a compliance timetable to be approved by the Agency.
- C. Petitioner shall submit monthly compliance reports on the last day of each month to the Agency.
- D. That Petitioner shall, within 28 days after the date of the Board order herein, execute and forward to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 2200 Churchill Road, Springfield, Il., 62706, and to the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 309 West Washington Street, Chicago, Il., 60606, a Certificate of Acceptance and agreement to be bound to all terms and conditions of the variance.

CERTIFICATION

The Olin Corporation, having read and fully understanding the Order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board in PCB 76-328, hereby accepts said Order and agrees to be bound by all of the terms and conditions thereof.
