INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

On July 14, 1977 Petitioner requested a variance from Rule 203(f) and 404(f) of Chapter 3: Water Pollution of the Board's Rules and Regulations. On August 15, 1977 the Agency filed its Recommendation in support of the variance with a proposed condition that an abatement order be entered against Petitioner. The proposed abatement order would be effective on May 1, 1978 in the event that Petitioner is unable to obtain voter approval of a bond referendum prior to that date.

At page 13 of the Petition for Variance a hearing is specifically waived so that an expedited decision could be obtained. It would be inappropriate for the Board to consider entering an abatement order without an opportunity for public comment. Consequently this matter shall be set for hearing at the soonest possible date.
