OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

The Board hereby adopts as its Proposed Final Draft in this matter, and orders publication of, the regulatory amendments set forth below. A public comment period will be allowed for 45 days from the date of this Order.

The Board's Proposed Final Draft differs from the Proponents' Amended Proposal, published in Environmental Register #138 (December 14, 1976), in that it substitutes the term "Freon Extractable Material" for the term "Hexane Extractable Material," and substitutes "monthly period" for "consecutive 30-day period."

## PROPOSED FINAL DRAFT

In Rule 408(a) of Chapter 3: Water Pollution, delete "Oil (hexane solubles or equivalent), and add "Oil (freon solubles or equivalent)" as follows:

*Constituent	Storet Number	Concentration (mg/l)
Oil (Freon Solubles or equivalent)	00 <b>550,</b> 00556 00560	15.00**

. . . .

\*\*Oil may be analytically separated into polar and non-polar components. If such separation is done, neither of the components may exceed 15 mg/l (i.e., 15 mg/l polar freon extractable materials and 15 mg/l non-polar freon extractable materials). Compliance with this numerical standard shall be determined on the basis of 24 hour composite samples, averaged over any monthly period; provided, however, that no single 24 hour composite shall be greater than 2 times the numerical standard and no grab sample shall be greater than 5 times the numerical standard."
