ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

International Harvester Company (Harvester) filed a Petition for Variance before the Board on September 1, 1976. On September 27, 1976, the Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative, to make more Definite and Certain. On October 18, 1976, the parties jointly submitted a Stipulation in which Harvester agreed to submit an Amended Petition in keeping with the objections raised in the Agency's Motion within 60 days of the date of the Stipulation. Harvester further agrees that the statutory 90-day requirement shall begin to run from the date of said Amended Petition.

The Board, accepts the Stipulation submitted by the parties and will entertain the Agency's Motion after the 60-day period has run.
