ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Dr. Odell)

On July 18, 1975, the Associated Milk Dealers, Inc. and The Soap and Detergent Association filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) a Motion To Cancel Hearings presently set for July 30 and August 6, 1975 on proposed changes to Rule 408(a) of the Board's Water Pollution Regulations. The proponents alleged that necessary test data were not completed and ready for presentation at hearing. The proponents requested that the matter be reset for a new date not less than six weeks from the time presently set. The unverified Motion stated that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency did not object to the requested continuance. The Metropolitan Sanitary District was also not opposed to the postponement of hearings.

We grant the Motion To Cancel Hearings. Hearings will be rescheduled in the near future when the proper preparation of the evidence has been completed.
