INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Zeitlin):

Petitioner Ashland Chemical Company and the Environmental Protection Agency are directed to more fully address the question of whether emissions from Petitioner's Mapleton, Illinois, plant would cause or contribute to a violation of national ambient air quality standards, were the requested Variance granted. The parties are further directed to submit such further data, interpretations or arguments as they may have on the issue within 14 days of the date of this Interim Order.
