

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T. E. Johnson):

On November 7, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until January 28, 2003, the time period within which Goben Oil Company may appeal a September 25, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency modified the proposed budget for the high priority corrective action plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 302 South Central in Casey, Clark County. Because petitioner failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
