ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):


Motion for Approval of Plan was filed on May 23, 1975 by Petitioner Commonwealth Edison Company (Edison), requesting the Board to approve its plan for installation of a Supplementary Control System (SCS) at its Kincaid generating station.

It is Edison's contention that the Pollution Control Board (Board) in its Order dated January 3, 1975, in paragraph 10(b)(iii) thereof, retained jurisdiction in PCB 74-16 for the purpose of final approval of its SCS plan. The Board finds that jurisdiction was retained in this matter for the purpose of scheduling additional hearings on the matter of the proposed SCS and to decide controversies between the parties.

As this motion raises no controversy, the Board feels that no relief is necessary, and therefore the motion is hereby denied.
