ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed November 21, 1974 is inadequate in that no rule is given from which variance is desired. Exhibit B seems to indicate compliance with particulate regulations. A violation must be shown or be imminent to warrant variance consideration.

Petitioner is ordered to file an amended petition within 45 days from the date of this order with the Board and Agency setting forth the rule or regulation from which variance is requested. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the needed information.
