ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On January 27, 1997 Land and Lakes/Willow Ranch (petitioner) filed a notice of extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act, relating to a January 14, 1997 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) determination. On February 6, 1997 the Agency filed its concurrence and a joint notice.

By order of February 20, 1997 the Board reserved docket PCB 97-126 for any petition which might be filed by petitioner. The order stated, "[i]n the event that petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before April 14, 1997 (the 90th day after January 14, 1997), the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary."

No petition has been filed. This matter is dismissed and the docket is closed as unnecessary.
