ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Marder)


Petitioner, R. Fox, Ltd., filed for variance on November 22, 1974. After review of said Petition, the Board finds that additional information on the following points is required in order to facilitate a reasoned decision:

1. The specific rule or rules from which variance is sought.
2. The amount of sulphur dioxide emitted.
3. Documentation of the unavailability of low-sulphur oil.
4. Petitioner's plans for compliance.

Petitioner is ordered to supply such additional information within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order. Failure to comply may result in the dismissal of this Petition on the grounds of inadequacy.
