ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Respondent filed a Motion For Stay of the above-captioned complaint on January 24, 1975. The Complainants filed a response in opposition on January 29, 1975.


Respondent seeks a stay until conclusion of two consolidated regulatory proposals, R74-15 filed by Republic Steel Corporation and R74-16 filed by the Illinois Petroleum Council, et al.

The above-captioned complaint alleges that Respondent is discharging cyanide in excess of present sewer discharge limitations found in Rule 703 of the Water Pollution Regulations. Because of the subject matter of the two pending regulatory proceeding is the same Rule 703, the Board agrees with Respondent that a stay of the enforcement case should be granted.

Respondent's Motion For Stay is hereby granted until the conclusion of the two regulatory proceeding, R74-15 and 74-16.
