OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Dr. Odell)

On April 4, 1974, the Pollution Control Board granted Petitioner a Variance from Rule 205(f) of the Illinois Air Pollution Regulations (Chapter Two). This Variance was subject to certain conditions and extended through July 1, 1974. Petitioner filed a Motion to Modify that Order on June 25, 1974. On evidence shown, we grant the Motion and hereby modify our Order in part. We extend the grant of Variance from 205(f) of Chapter Two through October 1, 1974, and modify condition 2 of our April 4 Order by changing the progress report date to September 1, 1974, and the date in condition 2(b) to October 1, 1974. In all other respects, the Order of April 4 shall remain in full force and effect.

Petitioner's Motion for Extension filed June 27, 1974, is rendered moot in the light of this Order of July 11, 1974.
