ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed April 1, 1974 is inadequate in that no information is given as to the proximity of residences or businesses or other places of human habitation or the ambient levels of air quality of carbon monoxide attained at these locations.

Petitioner is directed to amend the petition within 45 days by supplying the needed information. A waiver from the 90-day decision period set by statute shall be executed for the period elapsing until the amended petition is filed.

Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
