ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed April 22, 1974 is inadequate in that it gives a conclusory statement on NO_{X} levels achieved for only a two week period in May 1973. Since ambient air quality varies with wind speed and dilution any two week period may not be the most critical period of record.

Petitioner is ordered to furnish the data upon which the NO_X statement (p. 5 of Petition) is based and to initiate and provide additional monitoring data over as long a period is possible within the 60-day period from date of this Order.

An amended petition shall be filed within 70 days of the date of this Order containing the data requested. The 90-day decision period required by statute shall run from the date of filing of the amended petition.

Failure to timely file the information requested shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
