ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed April 24, 1974 is inadequate in that no data are given as to the number of patients to be housed in the nursing home; the strength and volume of the effluent; its impact upon the sewage treatment plant effluent and upon the receiving stream and the type of sewer ban (locally imposed or State-imposed) now in effect.

Petitioner is ordered to supply this information within 35 days from the date of this order. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing of the additional information.

Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
