ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On November 21, 2003, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until February 13, 2003, the time period within which Illinois Ayers Oil Company (Ayers Oil) may appeal a October 11, 2002, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. On February 13, 2003, Ayers Oil placed in the U.S. mail a petition asking the Board to review the Agency's determination. The Board received the petition on February 18, 2003. Because the petition's postmark date is within the extended filing period, the petition was timely filed. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2). The Agency rejected the high priority corrective action plan and associated budget regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 310 State Street in Beardstown, Cass County. Ayers Oil appeals on the grounds that the Agency's determination was contrary to the law and Agency precedent. Ayers Oil's petition meets the content requirements of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.408. The Board accepts the petition for hearing.

Ayers Oil has the burden of proof. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.112(a). Hearings will be based exclusively on the record before the Agency at the time the Agency issued its determination. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.412. Hearings will be scheduled and completed in a timely manner, consistent with the decision deadline (*see* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(2) (2002)), which only Ayers Oil may extend by waiver (*see* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.308). If the Board fails to take final action by the decision deadline, Ayers Oil may deem its request granted. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(2) (2002). Currently, the decision deadline is June 18, 2003 (the 120th day after February 18, 2003). *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.114. The Board meeting immediately before the decision deadline is scheduled for June 5, 2003.

Unless the Board or the hearing officer orders otherwise, the Agency must file the entire record of its determination by March 20, 2003, which is 30 days after Ayers Oil filed the petition. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.410(a). If the Agency wishes to seek additional time to file the record, it must file a request for extension before the date on which the record is due to be filed. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116. The record must comply with the content requirements of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.410(b).
