ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed June 21, 1974 is inadequate in that it refers to a previous proceeding, PCB 73-67, but does not stipulate to its use in its entirety in this case.

Petitioner shall within 45 days from the date of this order stipulate to the inclusion of the prior record or such parts as it is desired be considered. Furthermore, details as to past burning by date and quantity and complaints, if any, shall also be filed.

The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the additional information.

Failure to timely file the stipulation and additional information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
