ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed January 31, 1974 is inadequate in that it does not state (in paragraph 4) why construction of the sewer line and homes cannot begin. It is not clear whether an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ban is in effect and if so for what reason. The extent of the hardship upon the Pebble Creek entrepreneurs is not detailed in any way and the statements of the petition on this topic appear to be conclusory.

Petitioner is directed to amend the petition within 45 days from the date of this order to provide the needed information listed above. A waiver of the 90-day decision period shall be filed from the date of the filing of the original variance petition until the date of the filing of the amended variance petition.

Failure to timely file the amended petition shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
