
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed February 21, 1974 is inadequate. No showing is made that a violation of water regulations presently exists. It may not be necessary to perform a "field survey" on the stream but a Streeter-Phelps computation of the dissolved oxygen levels may be sufficient. It is not clear from which Rule or Regulation variance is desired.

Petitioner is ordered to supply the needed information in an amended petition within 45 days from the date of this order. The 90-day decision period shall run from the filing of the amended petition. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal because of inadequacy.
