ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed March 26, 1974 is inadequate in that no reason for the delay in achieving compliance is given nor are the environmental effects quantified in any way. Petitioner is ordered to give the strength and quantity of carbon monoxide emissions; the proximity of residences; and the ambient air quality resulting from the discharge for which variance is requested.

The information detailed above shall be filed within 45 days from the date of this order. Failure to timely file this material shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day period set by statute for a decision shall run from the date of filing the amended petition.
