ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Marder)

Barrett Varnish Company (Petitioner) has filed a motion for extension of variance granted in PCB 73-341 for two weeks so as to use up its inventory of cooking materials, and requests relief from the bond required in PCB 73-341 Order, Condition (D).

1. Extension of variance for two weeks from the date of this Order is granted.
2. Barrett shall supply a sworn affidavit attesting to the complete phase-out of the cooking operation within five days of such complete phase-out to the Environmental Protection Agency, upon receipt of which Barrett's bond requirement shall cease.
