ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle)

The petition filed September 6 is inadequate in that it does not state the Rule or Regulation from which variance is desired.

The statements given to lack of funds and resources are conclusory and are not substantiated in any way.


Petitioner is ordered to file an amended petition detailing the information required within 35 days. Petitioner shall file a waiver from the 90-day period for the period which has elapsed from September 6 to the date of filing of the amended petition.

Failure to timely file the information required shall make the petition liable to dismissal on the grounds of inadequacy.
