ORDER OF THE BOARD (BY SAMUEL T. LAWTON, JR.):

A variance expiring November 23, 1972 was granted to Commonwealth Edison Company from the provisions of Sections 201 and 202(1) of the Water Pollution Regulations with respect to the Company's Dresden Nuclear Power Station located near Morris, Illinois, in Grundy County.

The variance had been extended by subsequent orders of the Board to this date, pending resolution of a new petition for variance seeking extension to November 23, 1973, which petition was later amended to seek extension to April 1, 1974. For reasons that will be more fully set forth in the opinion to follow, we extend the variance to November 23, 1973.
