

Respondent has filed a petition in response to our June 14, 1973 Order, stating that Respondent had contacted various manufacturers of gas-fired afterburners to obtain estimates of delivery dates and that inquiry made of Peoples Gas, Light and Coke Company indicated that gas pressure of the amount needed for operation of the type of afterburner required, would not be available. Inquiry was next made with a view of obtaining a gas booster pump which Respondent now indicates has been made available. An afterburner has been ordered with delivery schedule of six weeks after approval of shop drawings, which will be ready on July 20, 1973. Installation and testing of the equipment is anticipated to take two weeks for completion. Stack testing would commence immediately after installation. Respondent asks that we permit the installation of the afterburner and gas booster pump and testing in accordance with the schedule provided.

If the contemplated program is implemented as Respondent represents, the equipment would be delivered by approximately August 31, 1973 and installed by September 14, 1973. Stack testing would commence immediately thereafter.

In view of the representations of the Respondent and the apparent good faith efforts to achieve compliance, we amend our April 17, 1973 order to grant Respondent until October 1, 1973 to complete its program of installation, testing and compliance pursuant to its proposed schedule and direct that all provisions of our earlier order be achieved by said date and that Respondent cease and desist all violation of the relevant Regulations and the Environmental Protection Act by October 1, 1973.
