Opinion & Order of the Board (by Mr. Currie):

Borden petitioned for extension of a schedule, set in a prior variance proceeding (#71-23, May 24, 1971), for compliance with the effluent standards of 4 mg/l BOD, 5 mg/l suspended solids, which at the date of filing the regulations required to be met by people in Borden's situation by July, 1972. Borden now moves to withdraw the petition, arguing no variance is necessary because of our recent revision of the regulations, which postponed the compliance date to December 1973 (Water Quality Standards Revisions, #R71-14, March 7, 1972). We need not decide whether or not we agree with this assessment; if Borden does not wish to seek a variance, there is nothing before us to be decided. The motion to withdraw is granted and the proceeding dismissed.
